





## Business Law in Daily Use

The following compilation of business law contains a large number of legal principles sustained by the courts coming up daily in business life stripped of their legal verbiage.

If a note is lost or stolen it does not release the maker; he must pay it, if the consideration for which it was given and the amount can be proven.

Notes bear interest only when so stated.

Principals are responsible for the acts of agents as long as they act within the scope of their authority.

Each individual in a partnership is responsible for the whole amount of the debts of the firm except in cases of special partnership.

Ignorance of the law excuses on one.

The law compels no one to do impossibilities.

An agreement entered into without consideration is void.

A note made on Sunday is void.

Contracts made on Sunday cannot be enforced.

A note by a minor is void. A contract made with a minor is void.

A contract made with a lunatic is void.

Signatures made with a lead pencil are good in law.

"Value received" is usually written in a note but is not necessary. If not written it is presumed by law or may be supplied by proof.

Checks or drafts must be presented for payment without unreasonable delay.

If the time of payment of a note is not inserted it is held payable on demand.

# Synopsis of the New War Revenue Law

---

## Taxes and Stamps Required

- Beer, Ale and Porter, Tax \$1.50 a barrel.
- Banks, Annual Tax, \$1.00 for each \$1,000.00 capital.
- Brokers, Annual Tax, \$30.00.
- Chewing Gum, 4c each box or package of a retail value of \$1.00.
- Commercial Brokers, Tax \$20.00
- Custom House Brokers, Tax \$10.00.
- Dealers in Tobacco whose sales exceed \$200.00 a year, Tax \$4.80 for each store or shop.
- Manufacturers of cigars whose annual sales do not exceed one hundred thousand cigars, Tax \$3.00. Larger sales in proportion.
- Parlor car seats or sleeping car berths, one cent for each seat.
- Pawnbrokers, Tax \$50.00.
- Promissory notes, not exceeding \$100.00, Tax 2c, 2c additional each \$100.00.
- Telegraph and telephone messages costing 15c or more, one cent.
- Theatres, Tax from \$25.00 for less than 250 seating capacity to \$100.00 for 800 or more seating capacity.
- Express and freight receipts exceeding 5c, 1c each shipment.
- Indemnity bonds, Tax 50c.
- Deeds, Tax when value of property exceeds \$100.00 exclusive of incumbrance and is less than \$500.00, 50c, and 50c additional for each additional \$500.00 net valuation.

# Synopsis of the Fish and Game Laws of Indiana

## Federal Open Seasons

Waterfowl (except wood ducks) September 1 to Demember 15.

Jacksnipe and Plover, September 1 to December 15.

Rails, coots and gallinules September 1 to November 30.

Woodcock October 1 to November 30.

No open season until September 1, 1918, for wood ducks, swans, band tail pigeons, little brown, sand hill and whooping cranes and shore birds except those named above.

Perpetual closed season for song birds and insectivorous birds.

Daily closed season from sunset to sunrise.

## It Is Unlawful

To hunt off your own premises without a license.

To kill, or possess either dead or alive except for breeding purposes any deer, wild turkey or pheasant.

To net or trap quail at any time.

To kill or possess quail or ruffed grouse before November 10 or after December 20.

To sell or offer for sale quail at any time.

To kill more than 15 ducks, geese, quail or other water fowl in one day.

To hunt squirrels before July 1 or after November 1.

To hunt rabbits with a ferret at any time.

To hunt with any kind of fire arm on Sunday.

To hunt on any land without first obtaining permission.

To sell or offer for sale any pike, pickerel, walleyed pike, perch, black bass, or other species of bass.

To shoot fish.

To take any pickerel or pike less than 12 inches long, any rock bass or crappie less than six inches long or black bass less than ten inches long.
